





THE LOCATION

IH Ellesmere Young Learner Centre is held in Ellesmere College in Shropshire countryside, just an hour away from Manchester and Liverpool and only a few miles from the Welsh border.

The world's oldest complete fossil was found in Shropshire.

Course content

Students follow a daily programme of 15 hours of English language lessons in the morning, while afternoons are spent learning outside of the classroom through exciting activities with new friends.

During the afternoon, students can choose from a number of sports and arts activities, with something for everyone. Sports can include tennis, football, basketball and swimming. Arts activities can include t-shirt painting, sketching, and performance arts.

Study trips are also a big part of the course, with one full-day and one half-day trip to places of interest in the UK included every week. Example trips include: a full-day trip to Legoland and the Sea Life Centre and a walking tour and ferry ride in Liverpool. Half-day trips include Chester Zoo and Llangollen Railway.

Students practise their English inside and outside of the classroom, for the best learning experience.

In the evenings, Discover English students will have an activity programme with a mix of sports, arts and crafts, and other activities such as quizzes and film night.



COACHING OPTIONS

Activities available with a professional coach at IH Ellesmere Young Learner Centre.

ADVENTURE

Active Adventure offers students the opportunity to try a range of different adventure sports such as climbing, archery, abseiling, high ropes courses, raft building or kayaking.

(There is an additional charge of £150 per week for this activity).



GOLF

Students will be coached in techniques such as golf swings, fitness and diet. Each session will end with students taking part in a round of golf on the centre's own golf course.



PERFORMING ARTS

Performing Arts focuses on a variety of skills, including body language, facial expressions, and set design. Students learn to command the stage and practise their performance, while working towards a final performance for the end of course show.



SWIMMING

Students will learn new skills and techniques while focusing on safety awareness and water confidence. The pool features a retractable roof meaning students can enjoy both outdoor and indoor swimming.



HORSE RIDING

Includes horse trekking through spectacular scenery, a fast hack, flat work and jumping. Stable management and maintenance are also covered.

Course content

Unlike our other Young Learner English programmes, this course has English lessons in both the morning and in the afternoon: 21 hours of English tuition per week by a qualified English teacher. It is an intensive course across English reading, writing, listening and speaking skills.

It is not all hard work though – English Plus classes are lively, interactive and fun. Students are encouraged to speak English at all times, and benefit from using the language with others their own age in different social situations.

Students will have 15 hours of general English lessons with the rest of the school then six additional hours focused on improving their spoken English with an exam at the end of their course.

Students also participate in sports, arts and crafts, and other activities. Aimed at practising English through fun and teamwork, the English Plus programme proves that it is possible to work hard and still have fun!

Study trips are also a big part of the course, with one full-day and one half-day trip to places of interest in the UK included every week. 

Course content

Over the two week course players will get to experience what it's like to be a professional footballer. They will have practical coaching sessions led by experienced and qualified coaches to develop their skills and take them to the next level. All coaches are UEFA qualified.

As well as practical sessions students will have classroom based sessions to give them information on diet and lifestyle as well as match analysis and target setting.

During the course, a professional football scout will attend training sessions and assess each players ability. The coaches delivering the sessions have had players offered trials by the likes of Manchester United, Manchester City and Everton.

At the end of the two week course players will take part in a full match to show off the skills they have learned along with a trophy ceremony.

CONDITIONS

By making a booking with International House Trust (trading as 'International House London') you agree to the terms and conditions as set out below. Unless specifically agreed in writing, these conditions have precedence over any other communications.

If you have made a booking via an agency, then your contract is with the agent and not with International House London.

Course availability and cancellation

Every attempt will be made to place students on the course of their choice. In the event of insufficient applications for a course, the school reserves the right to offer an alternative course of equal value or a refund. Acceptance onto a course with specified level requirements will be subject to a level test at the centre.

Age

For young learner programmes the minimum age is twelve, except at Frensham, Ellesmere and Edinburgh young learner centres where it is eight. Young learner programmes also have a maximum age of seventeen.

Insurance

It is highly recommended that all students have comprehensive travel, repatriation, medical and course insurance. For young learners we provide complementary insurance. Please see ihlondon.com/useful-information/insurance/ for more details.

British immigration regulations

If the student is a non-EU applicant, they may require a student visa. It is your responsibility to obtain this visa and we are not responsible if a student obtains the wrong visa. If a student requires a visa and arrives without one, they will not be eligible to attend the programme. Please note that all non-EU students must study for a minimum of 15 hours per week to comply with British immigration regulations.

A course may be terminated at any point if a participant is found not to have leave to remain in the UK or breaches the conditions under which they are in the UK.

Visa applicable support

We are a Student Visa (Sponsorships) under the UKVI's points-based system (no. 5BY3ENNA5) and we will provide the documentation required for students to apply for study visas where applicable. Documentation in support of study visa applications will only be provided after all fees have been paid.

The school has a legal obligation to collect and maintain application information, as well as passport and visa data, and inform the

Immigration Authorities about students whose attendance falls below the standard required by their visa.

If a visa application is unsuccessful, yet all documentation was correctly submitted, please send a copy of the visa refusal letter to our admissions team. A course fee refund will be issued when we receive this document.

Attendance and student holidays

Students are expected to attend lessons regularly and on time. Students forfeit course fees if they are late, absent, or leave before the course ends.

Airport and railway station transfers

We can provide transport from your airport or train station to your accommodation at prices stated in our price lists. Once booked these fees are non-refundable irrespective of whether or not the service is used. These fees must be paid at least six weeks before the transfer date.

Code of Conduct

The school reserves the right to terminate an enrolment without issuing a refund, where a participant's behaviour is such that it would be unreasonable for them to continue their studies.

Special offers

Discounts cannot be applied retrospectively to existing bookings and only one discount can be applied to a booking.

Variation to fees

We usually set, and hold, our fees for a calendar year. Fees are chargeable based on the fee for the course published in the brochure for the year in which you choose to study. However, if you book a course before 1st October for the following year you may choose to be charged the fee at the current rate. Please note that if you extend your course, additional weeks will be chargeable at the fee applicable on the date you extend your booking.

Deposits

All our courses require a deposit at the time of booking. Deposits are non-refundable, except under the visa refusal conditions detailed above. Deposits for individual students are £450, unless this is more than the course fee. Deposits for group bookings are a minimum of 10% of the total course fee. Deposit and payment terms will be outlined in the agreed Service Level Agreement (SLA).

Subject to a small leeway, to allow for funds to be transferred, until the deposit is paid, the 'booking', remains a quotation or an allocation, and the place(s) are not confirmed; they may be sold to another person.

Tuition Fees

The full fee should be paid the time of booking, and no later than 6 weeks before the start of the course. If not paid via our online booking system

an invoice will be raised immediate payment will be expected.

We do not allow students that owe fees to attend classes or enter our accommodation. Students unable to pay any balance at registration will be turned away and, where applicable parents, agents or sponsors informed. Students under 18 will be passed across to the care of local government social services.

How to Pay

All fees are stated in GBP. We prefer payment by credit card but will accept cash at our Stukeley Street Reception. For currencies other than GBP you will be charged the exchange rate applicable at the time of booking plus a handling fee dependent on the currency and amount.

We accept payment by MasterCard, Visa, American Express and JCB and you can pay via our website at the time of booking, or by phone. International students can pay via Flywire (www.flywire.com) or bank transfer to 30-65-41, 37995568. Please make sure that you quote your name in the reference section

We are not responsible for any bank service fees; it is the responsibility of the student to cover any amounts required to ensure that we receive the full student fee. Always quote the student number on bank transfers. Credit card payments are subject to a 1.5% handling fee for bookings which are not made online.

Force Majeure

In the event of 'force majeure', such as fire, flooding, pandemic, infectious diseases and other events outside our reasonable control which may cause the closure of the school, no refund of fees will be made to students, except at the school's discretion in exceptional circumstances.

Cancellations, changes and refunds

Should individual students need to cancel or postpone their study, the following refund policy applies. The information below relates to programme fees and excludes the deposit and registration fee which are always non-refundable:

- Up until ten working days before the start of the course – full refund or up to 12-month postponement
- Fewer than ten working days before arrival – 75% tuition refund or up to 12-month postponement
- After the course has commenced – no refund or postponement permitted

Health and safety

We operate a rigorous Health and Safety policy. Staff are all DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) checked and undergo a period of training and orientation prior to students arriving at the school. All the relevant student-teacher ratios are adhered to, as set out by the Children's Act and relevant governing bodies of language travel courses, such as English UK.

Airport transfers

If you have booked a shared airport transfer, students will be met by a member of our Young Learners Programme staff and accompanied to the school. Shared transfers are available from 10:00 until 19:00 from: London Heathrow and Manchester International Airport, and for Edinburgh, from Edinburgh International. For arrivals outside of these times or to other airports, clients can make their own way to the school or book a private transfer.

Clients are welcome to choose between a shared or private transfer during the hours of 10:00 and 19:00, but private transfers will be charged at the full private transfer rate. This includes a member of the school staff meeting the student at the airport and checking in the student at the airport upon departure.

Unaccompanied minors are charged an additional £60 one-way due to the additional staff resources needed to provide this service.

All travel details must be finalised and communicated to us at least 28 days before the start of the programme. Within 28 days we may have to arrange a private transfer, in which case the fee difference will be due before the course commences.

Code of Conduct

School rules will be sent out along with the joining documentation. While every effort will be made to contact parents or guardians regarding serious breaches of school rules, the centre manager may at his/her discretion impose sanctions, including suspension and expulsion. We reserve the right to dismiss any student whose standard of conduct is unsatisfactory. We do not refund fees in cases of expulsion and all costs incurred as a result must be paid for by the student.

All students are liable for loss or damage to school property for which they are responsible. A £50 cash deposit will be taken from all students upon arrival and returned at the end of the programme, providing no damage has been incurred.
