Options such as Exam or Academic Preparation are available for those who want to improve for school or university. Our Lifestyle Programme is available for those who prefer to learn through activities only, without lessons.

Adults & professionals

We offer total immersion programmes for adults of all ages and language levels seeking to learn or improve a foreign language while discovering a new region and culture, meeting people who speak the language, and engaging in enriching activities and interactions. Whether for leisure, work, a specific exam or personal goal, our qualified and experienced hosts design tailor-made programmes to meet the individual objectives of each adult participant.

Learning a language for professional purposes with a host teacher is the perfect way for adult learners to progress quickly in the subject of their choice. We have hosts with different areas of expertise such as business, marketing, tourism, science, etc. They are able to offer language courses using specific vocabulary and jargon in the chosen field. Adult students can also combine their Home Tuition Programme with General Activities, Cultural Visits, Sports or Excursions, which provide them with a unique insight into another culture, while they learn not only through theory but also through practice. For adults looking for a high standard of accommodation we offer a Superior Homestay Option with our most exclusive hosts.

GENERAL INFORMATION

DATES

Our courses are weekly.

Arrival takes place on a Sunday and departure on a Saturday.

Courses can be booked all year round.

For stays of 2 weeks or more the extra night between weeks (Saturday to Sunday) is free of charge.

1 week = 6 nights

2 weeks = 13 nights (1 night free)

3 weeks = 20 nights (2 nights free)

4 weeks = 27 nights (3 nights free)

PERSONAL INFORMATION

It is important that you give us as much information as possible about yourself (allergies, smoker/non smoker, language level, interests, etc.) in order for us to select the most suitable host family for you.

DESTINATION

We consider the choice of host family more important than the region so please give us several choices of area in the chosen destination when possible.

HOST SELECTION

Our Regional Managers have personally interviewed the host teachers and inspected their accommodation.

They have a recognised teaching certificate and/or a university degree and have a minimum of 2 years experience teaching.

They have been selected not only because they are dedicated and professional but also because they have a passion for teaching, can offer a comfortable and hospitable home, are warm, friendly and love sharing their daily life and culture.

Hosts can vary from the traditional family with two adults and one or more children, to one-parent hosts with one or more children or hosts who live alone. Some school teachers host and teach language students during their holidays, some who have retired enjoy teaching on an occasional basis, others enjoy teaching in a different way from home.





TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL STAY

CULTURAL DIFFERENCES

Hosts may not have the same way of life as you do, so please be ready to accept the cultural differences which are also part of your language immersion experience. Learning a language is also learning about the country where it is spoken and its people.

SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

Please note school holidays may not be on the same dates as in your home country so children may be at school during your stay.

POCKET MONEY

We recommend you bring £100, €120, US\$140 weekly spending money and double these amounts if you have not booked any leisure options.

ACTIVITIES & VISITS

Influent Hosts will welcome you in their home like a friend who has come to stay and will share their daily family life. If you would like cultural visits, activities, sports or excursions, these are options that should be added to your programme.

Activities and/or cultural visit options are strongly recommended for all students, as they enable you to continue practising your language skills outside of lessons as well as learning more about the country and region you are in.

△ Home Tuition Programme:

- 10 hours lessons must be combined with General Activities and/or Cultural Visits and/or Farm Activities.
- Students under 18 must book General Activities, Farm Activities and/or Cultural Visits.

△ Lifestyle Programme:

- 10 hours activities must be combined with Cultural Visits.

TRANSFERS

Please provide us with full travel details and a mobile number well in advance of your stay if you wish to book transfers.

△ Transfers are compulsory for students aged 15 and under unless taken care of by their parents.

BEFORE ARRIVAL

Our hosts are provided with full details concerning you, your preferences and the programme you have booked. We advise you to contact them before your stay to introduce yourself and tell them about your interests, food preferences and expectations. This will help them prepare for your stay.

If you have booked a course with lessons we advise you to complete our Online Language Test, the results are sent automatically to your host teacher, this will enable them to personalise the content of your language lessons in advance to suit your needs.

A Student Handbook is available on request, it contains all the information and answers to any questions you may have on your language immersion.

BEFORE DEPARTURE

Host Teachers fill in a Teacher's Report with full details concerning your lessons, activities and their comments, it is available on request.

We ask if possible for you to fill in an Online Student Report as we are interested in your feedback.

Your teacher can provide you with a Certificate of Attendance on request.

PROGRAMMES

HOME TUITION PROGRAMME

It is the most effective way to make rapid progress: you stay with your teacher who will give you private lessons tailored to your needs and goals. It completely immerses you in the language you are learning as you put into practice what you have learnt during your lessons through social interactions and meal times with your host.

The Home Tuition Programme includes:

- 10h*, 15h, 20h, 25h or 30h private language lessons per week
- Accommodation in your teacher's home
- Meals and social interaction with your host

Choose the number of language lessons you require and personalise your programme according to your needs, interests and preferences with a multitude of options and specialisations to choose from. Some things cannot be learnt by studying in the traditional way, fluency is achieved through living the language, using the target language constantly and in your everyday life. Culture, entertainment, leisure and current events are embedded in people's language and these are as much part of the language learning process as the lessons.

OPTIONS

GENERAL ACTIVITIES

Apply what you have learnt during your lessons, practise your language skills through varied family activities with your host or another adult member of the family.

Activities are decided between you and your host and can include:

Cooking/baking, shopping, bowling, mini-golf, a sport event, a ball game, cinema, theatre, sightseeing, conversation practice & debates, board games, nature walk, a local festival or event, a street or farmer's market, an outdoor outing (beach, picnic, lake, etc.), historic downtown, a typical village, a local place of interest, afternoon tea or country pub (18+), arts & crafts, etc.

▲ The nature of the activities depends on your interests and the host family's location.

All costs are included: the transport, entrance fees (if applicable) and activity expenses for the student and the accompanying person.

CULTURAL VISITS

Visit places of interest and/or museums with your host or another adult member of the family who becomes your own private guide.

Understanding the culture of your target language improves your experience and facilitates the learning process, it also enables you to practise your language skills in a different environment.

▲ Cultural Visits may vary depending on family location and availability.

SPORTS

Enjoy a minimum of 3 sport sessions weekly (number of sessions may vary depending on the sport and destination). Sessions are generally individual but sometimes take place with a group. They are usually held with a professional instructor and occasionally with a family member.

TRANSFERS

Transfers to/from airports, train stations or seaports can be arranged and are usually taken care of by the host, a private driver, or the Regional Manager. The required transfer location will be mentioned on the family profile. If you do not arrive/depart at the transfer location indicated, charges may be increased.

BUSINESS, PROFESSIONAL & SPECIALISED VOCABULARY

Designed to help you make rapid progress in the language you are studying and focused on the skills you need for your work. Improve your confidence and use of vocabulary through live practice for business meetings, negotiations, presentations and general communication with clients. Learn the skills and techniques for phoning, writing reports, e-mails or letters, through role playing. Improve your social skills for meetings and entertaining clients, travelling on business or attending conferences. Purely for business or with professional vocabulary for medicine, tourism, real estate, marketing, law, human resources, media, aviation, military, engineering, banking, accountancy, computing, architecture...

EXAM PREPARATION

Your teacher will design a course to prepare you for an exam (Cambridge EFL, TOEIC, TOEFL, IELTS, DELF, DELE, Baccalauréat, Abitur, Matura and other exams on request...). He or she will help you familiarise yourself with the test content, level and format, work on the different types of questions you may be

asked, review and improve your replies, go over your areas of improvement, give you past exam papers to help you practise.

PRIVATE BATHROOM

You share bathroom facilities with your host and the family unless you take the private bathroom option which gives you the use of your own exclusive bathroom for more privacy.

CLOSER SUPERVISION (-13)

As young learners they can benefit from a course specially designed for their needs. We offer close supervision in a friendly and caring household, and this option guarantees the presence of an adult at all times.

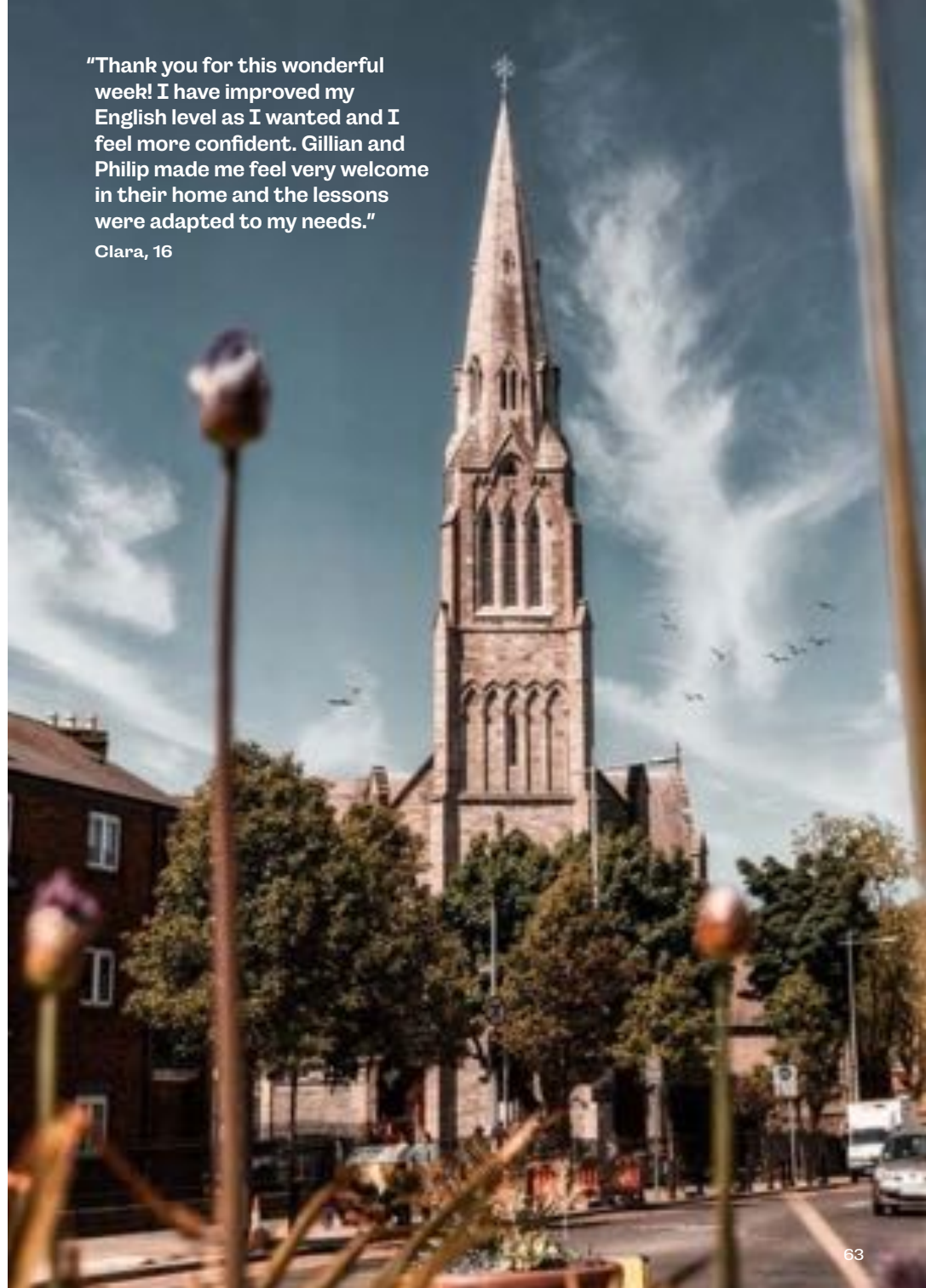

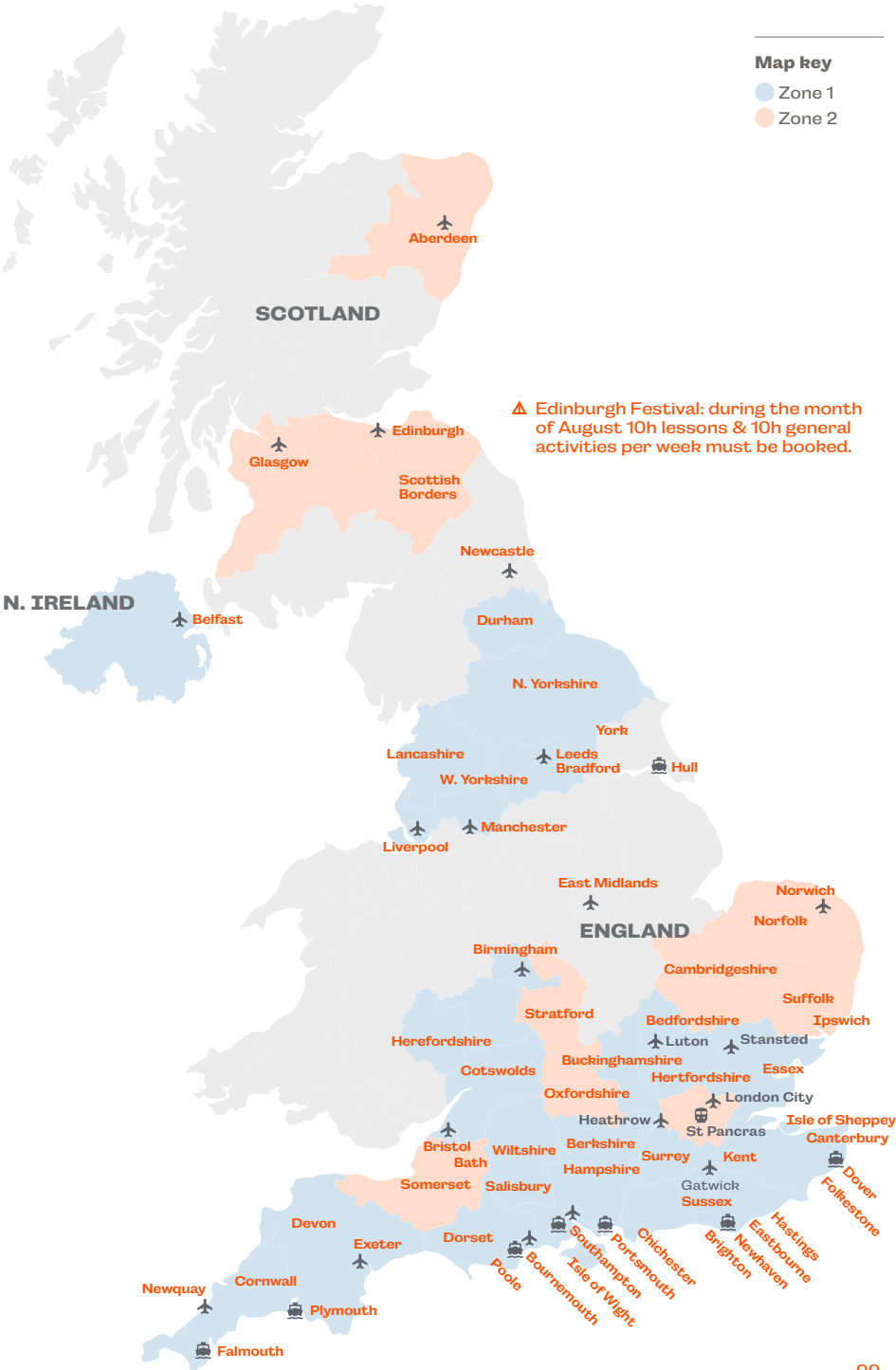

By enrolling you confirm you accept and you are aware of the following:

Our services

Influent offers language immersion programmes worldwide, for participants of all ages and levels.

You stay with a host and/or teacher, with other members of the host's family where applicable. Different types of stays are offered all year round and may include language courses, activities, visits or other options. Courses and/or activities or visits generally take place during the week, but can also be done at weekends and/or on public holidays, depending on the schedule decided upon by you and your host so that the total number of hours booked are completed by the end of the stay. One hour of language tuition in your private teacher's home = 60 minutes.

Enrolment

Upon receipt of your enrolment, we will select the host most suitable to your profile. You are free to refuse this proposal if you feel that the host does not meet your requirements, and we will propose another one. We consider that the choice of host is more important than the area so request several choices of area in the chosen destination if possible.

Host selection process

We organise stays for participants of all levels. It is essential that you indicate your language level when booking to allow us to select the host and/or teacher best suited to your profile and specific needs.

One participant/student is assigned per host or teacher, except in the case of a shared programme. The host family may have guests or friends at the same time as you provided that they are not of the same nationality or mother tongue as you and that this does not interfere with your lessons or stay.

To the best of our knowledge, the host's details are correct when we provide them, and we cannot be held responsible for subsequent changes to these.

We cannot guarantee that all the host family members will be present during your stay as our contract is with the host or teacher, not with other family members.

In some cases, you may be placed with two or more families during the course of the same stay (for long stays, for example).

Payment

Payment should be made 1 month before arrival, in the currency indicated on the invoice:

By bank transfer:

- To the account provided on the invoice

Or

By card:

- Using the payment link provided on the invoice

Insurance

Insurance is not included. You must take out your own insurance against illnesses, accidents, loss of property or cancellations.

Travel

Influent does not arrange travel. As this service is not included, you (or your parents/legal guardian in the case of minors) must take care of travel arrangements: flights, ferries, trains, etc. You should also find out about any formalities/documents required, depending on the country of departure and the destination, e.g. a valid passport or ID card, authorisation forms for minors travelling alone, ESTA, ETA, visas, health documents, etc. Please check with the embassies and consulates in your country and chosen destination. We cannot issue visas, but we can send you a letter of invitation or a certificate of acceptance if this is required to allow you to apply for one from the relevant authorities. You are solely responsible for obtaining all travel documents and visas required, and Influent cannot be held responsible for failure to obtain them, for inappropriate or incomplete documents, lack of information, or non-acceptance by authorities before or during the trip.

Transfers

Transfers can be booked as an optional extra. We can organise them to and from the airport, port or train station, depending on the host's location, and they will be taken care of either by a member of the host family or a driver.

We must receive travel details well in advance in order to arrange any transfers booked, one week before arrival at the very latest. If not, we reserve the right to cancel them.

A mobile number is required in all cases.

Transfers are usually individual but may be shared with students arriving/departing at a similar location and time.

A supplement may be charged for early arrivals and/or departures (before 8 a.m. or after 10 p.m.).

If no transfers are booked, you should contact your host directly to give them the appropriate arrival time. If the host does not hear from you, you will be expected after 7 p.m.

Cancellations

Cancellation fees are as follows:

- 28 days or more before arrival: £200, €250, USD250
- 27 days to 1 week before arrival: 50% of the fees
- Less than one week before arrival: 100% of the fees

Cancellation charges for Sports and/or Excursion Options may be added as they are usually booked by the hosts well in advance and are most often non-refundable.

Date changes

- A change of dates 28 days or more before arrival is not subject to an alteration fee.
- A change of dates 27 days or less before arrival is subject to an alteration fee of £200, €250, USD250.

Host cancellations

In the case of unforeseen circumstances (personal problems, health issues, etc.), should the family cancel before arrival or during the stay, a replacement host family will be provided.

Refusal by the participant of this replacement will be considered a cancellation and the relevant cancellation fees will apply.

Issues/Complaints

Regional managers in the host's country are always available to help you with any issues you may have, and these can usually be solved very quickly as they are often related to language misunderstandings or cultural differences. Problems that cannot be resolved are rare, but if you feel that you and the host are not suited, or you are not happy in the homestay, the regional manager or Influent must be contacted so that a change of host can be arranged. Claims after the stay will only be considered if we have been notified of issues during the stay. In the case of minors, this is the parent's or guardian's responsibility.

Privacy policy

In order to organise your immersion programme, Influent needs to collect certain personal data, in particular regarding your identity. In accordance with current EU legislation, you have the right to access, rectify and delete any personal data concerning you, by written request.
