

Payment

In order to secure the booking, a £500 deposit must be sent within one week of receiving the booking confirmation documents from Bucksmore. Full payment is required not less than 8 weeks before arrival. Payment will be expected by return for bookings made within 8 weeks of arrival. Students whose fees have not been paid in full will not be permitted to join their programme with Bucksmore.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations must be made in writing to Bucksmore Head Office. Once booking confirmation has been received, the following cancellation fees will apply:

- 30 days or more prior to arrival - 25% of total fees
- 7-29 days prior to arrival - 50% of total fees
- 0-6 days or more prior to arrival - 100% of total fees

Teacher Selection Process


Teachers go through a rigorous five-step recruitment process before becoming an active Bucksmore Home Tuition teacher. This process includes a comprehensive interview, police background and reference checks, and a full home inspection.

Inspections

Before a student can study with a teacher, a member of the Head Office team inspects the teacher's home and meets their family, with further inspections every two years.

Support

The head office team monitors courses and student progress constantly - which includes collecting initial student feedback to check on progress and satisfaction.
