THE LOCATION


IH Edinburgh Young Learner Centre is held in Newbattle Abbey College: a beautiful location full of character and interest, providing a well-equipped and comfortable learning environment.

Edinburgh's World Heritage Site covers almost 2 square miles and over 75% of all the buildings are listed (meaning they are of national importance and historical interest)

Edinburgh Castle sits on Castle Rock, a 700 million year old extinct volcano.

Newbattle Abbey College was originally a Cistercian monastery founded in 1140, it then became a stately home, before being gifted to the Scottish nation and becoming an educational institution. The college is eight miles south of Edinburgh and set in a campus with ornamental gardens and lawns.

It is an iconic building with a Great Hall, Old Library and spacious classrooms, with woodland walks and sports fields in the grounds.

Course content

Students follow a daily programme of English language lessons in the morning with a focus on the environment, sustainability and the natural world. Afternoons are devoted to outdoor learning where teamwork, creative thinking and confidence building are intertwined with adventures in the woods.

Activities will connect their classroom studies to the natural world. Field studies and collaborative projects and challenges will increase their appreciation of the outdoors. The course also covers basic bushcraft and survival skills where students will be able to delve into foraging, shelter building and first aid.

Each week there is also one full-day excursion further afield so students can make the most of their time in Scotland by seeing the highland mountains, castles and famous Scottish cities. There is one afternoon per week spent in Edinburgh for sightseeing.

There are on-site evening activities organised by IH staff every night, including quizzes, camp fires, film nights and a disco.




Course availability and cancellation

Every attempt will be made to place students on the course of their choice. In the event of insufficient applications for a course, the school reserves the right to offer an alternative course of equal value or a refund. Acceptance onto a course with specified level requirements will be subject to a level test at the centre.

Age

For young learner programmes the minimum age is twelve, except at Frensham, Ellesmere and Edinburgh young learner centres where it is eight. Young learner programmes also have a maximum age of seventeen.

Insurance

Shared transfers are available from 10:00 until 19:00 from: London Heathrow and Manchester International Airport, and for Edinburgh, from Edinburgh International. For arrivals outside of these times or to other airports, clients can make their own way to the school or book a private transfer.

Clients are welcome to choose between a shared or private transfer during the hours of 10:00 and 19:00, but private transfers will be charged at the full private transfer rate. This includes a member of the school staff meeting the student at the airport and checking in the student at the airport upon departure.

Unaccompanied minors are charged an additional £60 one-way due to the additional staff resources needed to provide this service.

All travel details must be finalised and communicated to us at least 28 days before the start of the programme. Within 28 days we may have to arrange a private transfer, in which case the fee difference will be due before the course commences.

Code of Conduct

School rules will be sent out along with the joining documentation. While every effort will be made to contact parents or guardians regarding serious breaches of school rules, the centre manager may at his/her discretion impose sanctions, including suspension and expulsion. We reserve the right to dismiss any student whose standard of conduct is unsatisfactory. We do not refund fees in cases of expulsion and all costs incurred as a result must be paid for by the student.

All students are liable for loss or damage to school property for which they are responsible. A £50 cash deposit will be taken from all students upon arrival and returned at the end of the programme, providing no damage has been incurred.
