Not Only Skiing and Snowboarding

Alongside our full-day ski and snowboard lessons Les Elfes offers a full programme of après-ski and evening activities. Students can choose from a range of activities including sledging, igloo building, torchlight hike, disco, ice skating, design and build challenges, swimming, indoor rock climbing, quiz night, football, basketball, hockey, snowman building and many, many more.

Ski and Snowboard lessons

Our lessons are split into morning and afternoon sessions. In the morning campers learn new skills and techniques with their instructor and after lunch their instructor guides them around the mountain so that they can practice and consolidate these new skills. Our groups are small with 2-8 students per instructor and our instructors are fully qualified and trained in partnership with Ecole Suisse de Ski Verbier, the official Swiss ski school in Verbier.

First Time Away From Home

Camp is full of new things, new places, new foods, new people and new adventures and it is a really special experience for our youngest Elves, but it can also be a daunting prospect for them and for their parents. Ensuring their happiness and wellbeing throughout the camp and helping them to manage away from home is our main priority in our Discovery Camp La Tzoumaz. Our La Tzoumaz camp offers an adapted programme from our main campus which is a little shorter than the sessions at the main camp. It is a specially designed programme of day, afternoon and evening activities to help our young Elves grow, step outside of their comfort zones and discover new things. With the right structure and support camp is an empowering experience which enables our youngsters to become more confident and to build self-esteem.

Babysitting

We monitor students in brushing their teeth, tidying their belongings, separating their clean and dirty clothes, brushing their hair, dressing suitably for activities, showering regularly, keeping in contact with their parents each evening, managing their time to squeeze in the most fun and even budgeting their pocket money.

Activities

Our Discovery programme is packed with new adventures: treasure hunt, biking, arts and crafts, pj party, rock climbing, football, design and build, mountain hut night, high ropes course, baking workshops, hiking, team building, quiz night, mini Olympics, high ropes, aqua park, orienteering, disco, swimming, campfire and many more...

Young Camper Attitudes

At Les Elfes we strive to install positive attitudes in our young campers that will help them to cope with any new experiences in the future:

- **Independence** - Being away from home, managing their own belongings, learning to care for the equipment they use and the camp environment they are a part of.
- **Resilience** - Learning that making a mistake is often the first step but that it does not need to be the final one. Learning to work in a team to complete difficult tasks.
- **Confidence** - Learning to cope in an unfamiliar setting, trying new activities in a safe and supportive environment.

6 REASONS TO SEND YOUR CHILD TO CAMP

1. Make lifelong friends

There is no better place to create lasting bonds with others than the experience of being away at camp. Spending 2-4 weeks with a new group of people, sharing adventures and supporting each other when things get tough. It is something they will remember for the rest of their lives!

2. Develop life skills

Do not underestimate how important it is for children to learn to socialise. At camp students come from around the world, often not knowing anyone and in their first few days they have the chance to make brand new friends and to learn to speak to new people. They will have the chance to learn to organise their belongings, manage their own pocket money and plan some of their own activities, making choices about the experiences they have. Being at camp is a really formative experience and an invaluable one in learning to become an adult.

3. Gain confidence & build self-esteem

Students learn that they have the capacity to cope without their parents, to make friends and to have adventures alone. It is a really empowering experience and will ultimately enable them to be more confident and to build self-esteem. It is a great confidence booster for those who are about to travel for boarding school or college.

4. Experience a range of cultures

Where else can children develop friendships with other children from all over the world at the same time? The huge melt pot of diversity at Les Elfes enables students to build lasting relationships with students from the other side of the world and perhaps even visit them someday.

5. Un-plug for a little while

It would be an easy option for most children to while away their summer watching television or playing on their iPads, but there is so much more out there! At camp we do allow students to use the phones each day to speak with their families and friends at home but, for the most part, their electronics are locked away, freeing them up to try all of the new activities on offer. In our experience, after day 3 students stop even asking for their phone every day, they are too busy having fun!

Camp is full of new things, new foods, new activities, new people. It is a place which is exciting, exhilarating and sometimes a little bit scary, but it is those experiences shared with others in the groups which help to form these strong, long lasting friendships that we value.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. RESERVATIONS

All reservations are confirmed through Les Elfes Int SA, a company registered with the Swiss Chamber of Commerce.

No reservation is valid unless Les Elfes Int SA has received this signed contract, accompanied by the required advance deposit, or the total amount due to the camp if less than 30 days separates the date of registration and the beginning of the session.

The person signing the registration form certifies to Les Elfes Int SA that he/she has the legal right to represent the participant registered (and if the participant is under 18 years of age, the authorisation of the parents, of the group leader or of the legal guardian) and to enter into this contract with Les Elfes Int SA and that each registered participant accepts all of this contract's conditions.

This contract is governed and interpreted under Swiss laws and jurisdiction.

No addition, deletion, modification or promise can be made regarding these terms and conditions, except in writing, by a representative or director of Les Elfes Int SA.

2. FINAL PAYMENTS AND REFUNDS

The total programme cost for the session, including charges for supplementary items, must be deposited to Les Elfes Int SA before the beginning of the camp. The required advance deposit is non-refundable. The balance is refundable up until 30 days before the beginning of the session and after this date is non-refundable, except if you meet point 10 of Les Elfes Int SA general conditions. In the event that a student is expelled from the camp on the grounds of gross misconduct or breach of Les Elfes Rules (see point 6.), no refund will be given. Les Elfes Int SA also reserves the right not to refund any camp fee due to students cutting their stay short.

3. EVENTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF LES ELFES

War or risks of war, terrorist activities, political instability, riots, civil wars, industrial conflicts, natural disasters, closing of airports, technical problems or airplane accidents or other transportation accidents, fire, bad weather or any other events, or Acts of God beyond the control of Les Elfes Int SA that may affect the running of the camp programme, will not be the responsibility of Les Elfes Int SA. If the direction decides that the camp cannot be run for one reason or another, Les Elfes Int SA will refund the total amount of money received. If the participant decides on his/her own not to participate in the camp although it will be normally run, the participant cannot claim any refund from Les Elfes Int SA. Snowboarding can be chosen however in the case a camper is the only one in the class, this shall be deemed a private lesson and therefore incur an extra charge of 100CHF per ski day.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES

Les Elfes Int SA gladly assumes full responsibility for the programme arrangements reserved and will do its best to fulfil these. However, Les Elfes Int SA cannot be responsible for certain events that are not in control of Les Elfes Int SA. For example, ski-lifts, certain hotels, airlines or other public transport companies, or other parties such as mountain guides, specialised monitors etc. Therefore, Les Elfes Int SA clearly states that it cannot be held responsible for extra costs, complications, losses, injuries, damage, accidents, lateness or inconvenience due to any error made by a company, or other persons in regard to the benefits offered in the reservations, during the activities or during transportation of participants unless some negligence or lack of diligence on the part of Les Elfes Int SA can be proven. If a reservation is made, through an external collaborator or independent agent of Les Elfes Int SA, all complaints regarding their services should be made directly to the concerned party or parties. Each parent or group leader must sign, date, and return the consent form along with all annexed sheets describing the activities.

5. PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITIES

The parents, the group leader or legal guardians assume full financial responsibility for each participant: they register (children or young adults) for the following:

- Damages caused, voluntarily or not, to facilities, equipment, material or other objects belonging to, or rented by, Les Elfes Int SA.
- Costs of repatriation of participants required to return home or to a specified place for reasons of health, accident, bad behaviour or other reasons judged as valid by Les Elfes Int SA.
- Pocket money and all other personal purchases made by the participant except for articles clearly stated in the reservation
- All equipment rented or purchased which is deemed necessary for the participant to take full advantage of his/her holiday which is returned by the participant in bad condition or which may be lost, missing or damaged.

Les Elfes Int SA reserves the right to send the participant back to his/her home or to his/her group leader, if, during the session, the participant exhibits behaviour which is incompatible with the well-being of the camp or if the participant fails to observe the rules established by Les Elfes Int SA. Each parent or group leader will sign and return the annexed rules.

7. SKI CONDITIONS

Les Elfes Int SA cannot be held responsible for weather or snow conditions which may interfere with the ski program. If Les Elfes Int SA judges that the conditions for skiing are dangerous or unsuitable due to the weather, the ski program may be delayed or cancelled, even if the ski-lifts are functioning. If for any reason the ski season has to be cancelled, substitute activities will be provided for the participants. Only if Les Elfes Int SA is compensated by refund from the ski-lift central office, will the full amount of any such refund be divided among the participants involved.

8. CIVIL RESPONSIBILITY INSURANCE

Les Elfes Int SA holds a Civil Responsibility Insurance policy issued by Generali. This policy settles all claims arising from legal liability of the participant for accidental injuries or accidental damages or loss to the property of third parties: The maximum amount insured is CHF 5'000'000.- per incident.

9. HEALTH AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Health and accident insurance is mandatory. Les Elfes Int SA has a health and accident insurance for its participants. This insurance is compulsory for each participant who participates with Les Elfes Int SA and includes coverage for all sickness or accidents in Switzerland. The mandatory policy costs CHF 120.- per week. Pre-existing illnesses will not be covered. The insurance covers only expenses from the moment of arrival in Switzerland until the departure from Switzerland.

10. CANCELLATION POLICY

The cost of the trip cancellation covers the cancellation of the trip due to illness or accident of the participant or death of one of family members. To claim the insurance, the participant has to fill in adequate proof such as medical certificate on illness from a certified medical practitioner or the death certificate. It is mandatory for every participant to pay for these costs. The premium is 50CHF per week and covers all the land package. The Policy covers the full value of the camp fee without any deductions and is enforceable after the full camp fee including options that has been received by Les Elfes Int SA and is valid in case of cancellation from one month to one day before the beginning of the registered session. If this insurance is not valid please refer to point 2 of Les Elfes Int SA general conditions

11. CANCELLATION OR MODIFICATION OF PROGRAM

Les Elfes Int SA reserves the right to cancel any of the sessions mentioned in its brochure due to insufficient numbers of participants or for any other reason at the discretion of Les Elfes Int SA. If this rare event should arise, Les Elfes Int SA will offer to its participants the possibility of choosing another camp session or programme of Les Elfes Int SA or full reimbursement of the money deposited.

12. PUBLICITY MATERIALS

Les Elfes Int SA reserves the right to use all photographs of participants, or work completed by participants or other persons, for its future publicity purposes.

13. MEDICAL TREATMENT

Les Elfes Int SA will take any and all necessary action for the well-being and health of the child. This contract authorises Les Elfes Int SA to take action to assure medical treatment of the child, in the event of accident or injury, at the discretion of Les Elfes Int SA. All costs of medical treatment will be the responsibility of the parent, the group leader or legal guardian.

14. IMPORTANT

I have understood the information in the brochure of the institution Les Elfes International Camp in 1936-Verbier, Switzerland. I confirm with my signature that I know my child will participate in sports activities with inherent risks during the course of this camp. Particular swimming, skiing, snowboarding, soccer and (optional) paragliding. I also confirm the knowledge that these activities take place under the responsibility of Les Elfes Int SA monitors and also under the responsibility of companies or third persons carefully chosen and contracted by Les Elfes Int SA. I have understood and signed the consent form in addition to the explanatory note on each activity, with its description, its risks, and the security measures specific to it, the qualifications of the monitors, guides or other person in charge of taking care of, helping or advising the participants. I accept that these choices are discerning and that the measures are suitable and sufficient. In my role as legal representative of child, I accept these risks and I authorize my child to participate in sports activities under these conditions.
