18.00 DINNER

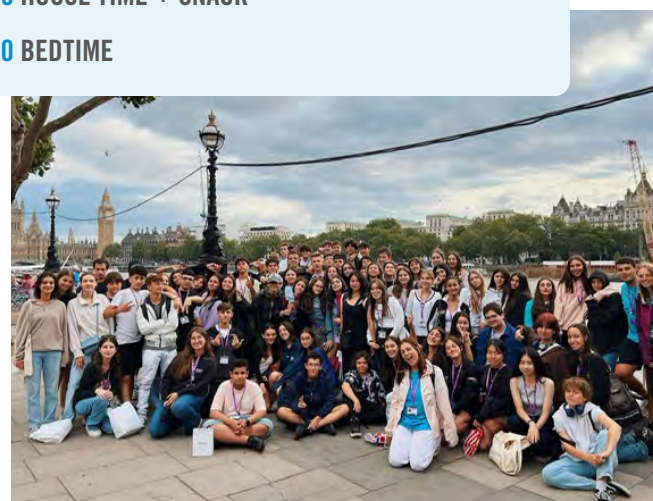
